ABOUT THE JUNIOR IMPACTENSEMBLE

Since 2011, The Empire Youth Arts IMPACT Ensemble Program has challenged the assumptions made about young people and their crucial role in our ever-changing world, and its future, through storytelling and performance.

IMPACT is an advanced performance-making theatre program. It offers young creatives an opportunity to share a story which speaks authentically and powerfully with the voice of young people, while presenting itself with the quality and care of professional theatre.

Entry is based on audition. Our Junior Ensemble (ages 10-14) will work across the first half of the

year to rehearse a two show performance season for public audiences at The Empire, Armitage Centre.

The IMPACT program has established a platform for youth voice to be heard within our region, and continues to nurture and invest in the development of empowered young artists.

The team behind the table are there to support you and make your time in the room a positive one, regardless of outcome.



The year is 2079. Humans are created with gene selection technology, Artificial Intelligence is part of everyday life and children's best friends are their Learning Bots. Except for Jerry.

Jerry is not like the others.

Neither is Neutron Finch, an exceptionally clever Learning Bot who seems to appear out of nowhere. He is smarter than most Bots, funnier and also possibly illegal. It doesn't take long for the status quo to unravel and one night, Jerry and his classmates are summoned to the oval...

Soul Trading is a fast-paced, clever and hilarious exploration of an impending future for young people. A work both deeply philosophical and plenty of fun,this play for young actors is universally resonant and will delight audiences and performers alike.

For the 2025 Junior IMPACT Ensemble, we are looking for a unique cast of 12 young people between 10-14 years, ready to challenge themselves and push their performance skills.

Under the guidance of Youth Arts Lead and Director Grace Sankey, this group of curious and creative young minds will work closely together across four months towards a public performance outcome on The Empire's Armitage Centre Stage. Commitment to this project is high priority for all involved, so please carefully review the rehearsal schedule on the next page prior to applying.

The Empire Youth Arts IMPACT Ensemble programs have a long history of supporting young artists in a process that is transformative, empowering and relevant to the social issues faced by our young people today. YOUR AUDITION

The IMPACT Ensemble is all about giving the region's most exciting, curious, and passionate young artists an opportunity to be both seen and heard, as they make their impact on our local performing arts scene. For the best chance to book a part, please make sure you read the information below carefully so you have all the knowledge for a successful audition.

In addition to seeing your talent, we are also interested in meeting you and learning about curiosities. We want to see your imagination and your instincts for performance, your abilities for team work and collaboration, and your authentic self!

You will be auditioning for the Director and 1- 2 other members of the Creative Team. We will be looking for 12 young people to be part of this years ensemble. Half the cast will play the roles of Learning Bots, so you will be encouraged to showcase your best robot interpretation as part of your audition!

You will have just 5 minutes to share with us BOTH of the following two tasks:

TASK 1

Perform one of the monologues found on the next page. We want to see how you interpret character with your voice and body. Be brave and take risks!

TASK 2

You will be asked to read a selection from scene 1 of the play with one of the panel. This scene should not be memorised and we will provide a copy of it in the room, however you should be familiar with it! The character you read will be determined in the room with the director depending on your preference.

Audition Tip: We know you may feel nervous coming into the audition room, but we are there to support you! Being prepared will help you feel more confident and relaxed in the room.





AUDITION TASK ONE

Please select and prepare ONE of the monologues below.
Please note that characters are not specific to any one gender, race or physical ability. Young performers from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

MONOLOGUE 1 - JERRY (human)

T5000 told me to go study bees but it was boring just reading about them on the computer and I wanted to see a real live one because they've been extinct for so long. I just love bees and it's SO SAD that they went extinct, you know, we humans should never have let that happen!

And now we have robot bee drones to do all the pollinating and they're not the same so I just wanted to see if I could print off a real live bee and so I DID! And I called him Boris. And then he vanished. And then I printed Neutron. Uh oh.

MONOLOGUE 2 - NEUTRON (bot)

We are your soulmates, correct? Jerry called me that within three minutes of us knowing each other.

But it's too much. It's not fair to you to pretend we can offer that kind of commitment. We can't be everything you want us to be when we lack the very thing that makes us a soulmate. A soul.

Look, it's not you, it's us. But we are only going to hurt you if we continue these relationships. You will keep wanting more from us than we canoffer and ultimately, jeopardise your own growth.

And therefore, it is with a heavy but non-emotional robot heart valve, that we have all decided to withdraw from your lives.

MONOLOGUE 3 - VIOLET (human)

They've gone. Oh my god. They've gone. MARIGOLD! You heard what that psycho robot said!

He's convinced them that they're bad for us! I didn't even get to say goodbye! I WILL NOT CALM DOWN! Marigold has turned into a Kamikaze Bot and it's all Jerry's fault! He's the one that brought Neutron into our lives. He and his self-raising mother!

Interested in the world beyond the stage? The ins and outs of putting on a production? Each year IMPACT has invited young artists to join the Junior IMPACT creative team, where they will learn invaluable skills in theatre making and production.

The Assistant Creative is a volunteer role open to interested young people ages 14 - 18. Anyone within this age bracket, of any experience level is invited to apply.

ASSISTANT CREATIVE ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

WORK WITH THE DIRECTOR IN AREAS OF INTEREST SUCH AS:

- working with actors (blocking, devising,character development)
- · set and costume design
- AV and video devising/creation
- · stage management
- and/or lighting and sound design

The Assistant Creative can be as involved as they'd like in each of these areas, perhaps preferring to observe and learn from the Director, or jump in with big ideas.

The Assistant Creative will be asked to stand by for absent actors, either by filling in for rehearsals or by taking and passing on missed notes and communication.

The Assistant Creative is required to attend all rehearsals and performances.

The Assistant Creative is expected to treat the role with respect and maturity, aware that they will be taking a leadership role of their peers.
